Whether you're looking for a Farm Stay as a way to show your children their family's rural heritage or as part of a comprehensive family enrichment and education process, at High Tower Ranch, you'll enjoy an authentic ranch-life experience from the ranch house to the barns to the hay fields. We've got it all - animals, chores, special homemade creations, cowboys, gardens, and more. Your family can pick the activities that best suit their interests and create vacation memories that will be cherished for a lifetime.



We have playful goats, dogs, cats, horses, mules, cows, chickens and ducks. Children and goats enjoy climbing the low, broad-limbed trees around the ranch house. Chicken and duck eggs are collected every morning, preferably by our younger guests. After the baby goats are weaned, the nanny goats are milked every day. (We use the milk to make cheese.) All the critters in our care need to be fed at least once a day.

Around the ranch, guests can watch the farrier put shoes on horses, help with the larger animals, or go for a horseback ride. There is an abundance of wildlife near the ranch - deer, hawks, eagles, raccoons and, sometimes, skunks!

In the evening, our guests can cheer on the local cowboys and cowgirls who gather for team roping events. Campfires are also a regular evening activity with Steve accompanying the sing-a-long on his guitar.
